Prof. Jude Kong shared some exciting opportunities for the teams to consider as they work on not only their projects but also establishing themselves as local leaders in the field.

Prof. Kong introduced Dr. Katharina Lauer from Arfinity, a company specializing in interpreting complex scientific data related to infectious diseases. Dr. Lauer emphasized their role in informing mitigation strategies and advising policymakers, with a focus on pandemic preparedness and vaccine decision-making.
