



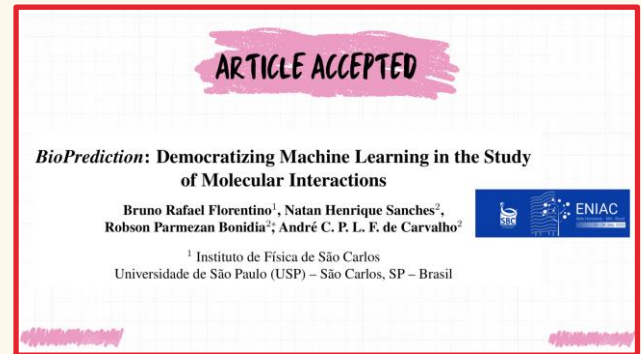
AI4PEP (SSA) News Bulletin 3 - August 20 to September 3, 2023



Welcome to the AI4PEP bi-weekly News Brief. In this edition, we present the highlights from the third Asia cohort bi-weekly meeting, featuring updates from Brazil, Dominican Republic, and Peru.

Prof. Kong introduced a collaborative opportunity: responding to a UN Call for papers on AI Governance. Bonidia (Team Brazil) volunteered to lead, promoting a comparative analysis approach to highlight diverse perspectives.

Team Brazil focused on countering fake news by empowering users to discern credible health information. Remarkably, they achieved 94% accuracy in identifying reliable sources. Another key achievement was that their paper was accepted for publication. It was titled: "BioPrediction - Democratizing Machine Learning in the Study of Molecular Interactions."
