

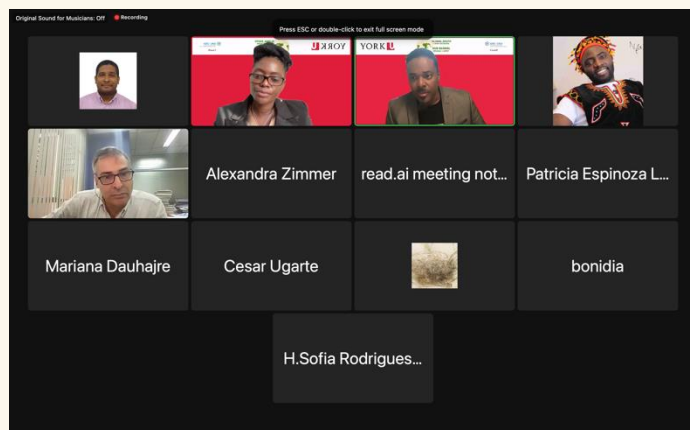
Welcome to the AI4PEP bi-weekly News Brief.

This week we bring you some exciting updates from Team MENA: **Brazil, Dominican Republic, and Peru.**

Resource Mobilization

The team spent a great deal of time and energy exploring opportunities for fundraising. Prof. Kong reiterated his initial commitment to double the funding by the second year. He shared with the team that there was an open call for proposal from the Grants Challenge, which includes a call by the Gates Foundation, as well as another one from the Wellcome Trust. Team Brazil volunteered to take a lead in investigating Latin America's eligibility and prospects of Partnership with the Sub-Saharan Africa cohort. Considering the tight deadline, which was within 5 days, the team reached a consensus that they would need to work on the grant over the weekend and observe the sensitive timelines of the intermittent feedback.
