Brazil Shines at COP 28

- Prof. Carvalho apologized for her absence in the previous meeting. He mentioned that he had attended the COP28 where he had a chance to present under the theme: Prototypes of Humanity. This presentation was selected among 1000s others & the presentation helped him profile the work that he was doing with AI4PEP.
- He mentioned that Robson had also received an award (honorary mention) for his teaching on Responsible AI.



Dominican Republic

Prof. Colome reported that they had won another research award alongside Drs. The title of the award was “Determinants of

Childhood Immunization Status: Addressing the Equity Gap in the Dominican Republic-2019.”

Dr. Colomé was one of three doctors who received, on December 11, the National Prize for Medicine in the Dominican Republic.
